Entries: Must be **POSTMARKED no later than MONDAY, JULY 20, 2009.**
(NO METERED MAIL – CANCELLED POSTMARK ONLY)
Entries must be submitted on BERNALILLO COUNTY OPEN YOUTH RODEO ENTRY FORM only – NO EXCEPTIONS. First Come, First Serve – NO EXCEPTIONS.
Absolutely no late entries or phone-ins. Entry must be accompanied with notarized Bernalillo County Open Youth Rodeo Waiver and Photo Release form. No Waiver Form – No Entry – NO EXCEPTIONS. Provide copy of contestant's birth certificate with entry to insure proper and fair age group entries.

NO CASH OR PERSONAL CHECKS accepted. Money Order or Cashiers Check only must accompany entry form. **No entries will be accepted** unless accompanied by **FULL ENTRY FEES.**
- Set ups:** Set ups on a **first come, first serve** basis, all setups will be at Rodeo Secretary's discretion, and are not guaranteed. Must list two (2) setup requests. If a second request is not listed and performance is full, setup will be at Rodeo Secretary's discretion. Once a performance is filled, second choice will be utilized. We reserve the right to make performances even. **Team ropers coordinate same requests for same performances.**
- Payback:** Checks will be mailed to winners within seven (7) days of the last performance. Payback will be based on 50% of entry fees. Each event pays back four (4) places – 40%, 30%, 20%, 10% with the exception of Mutton Bustin' where each contestant will receive an award in lieu of payback.
- Drawout:** Deadline is July 28, 2009.
- Coggins Test:** All rodeo Horses must have a current Coggins test.

Contestants may warm up horses in Tingley Coliseum from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. for the Thursday, Friday, and Saturday night performances and 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. Saturday before slack. Slack will start at 9:00 a.m. Saturday morning (if needed).

ARENA DRESS CODES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. This includes chute help and adults.
ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL!!! There is a No appeal process to the judges' decision. See Bernalillo County Open Youth Rodeo Rule Book. Failure to understand rules will not be accepted as an excuse.
