Buyer purchasing project animals from the sale have 3 options.

- 1) Buyers may purchase the animal for their own personal consumption.
- 2) Buyers may sale the animal back to the packer at market value. (Buyers would pay the purchase price minus the market value).
- 3) Buyers may donate the meat to the charity of their choice.
