


Important: All funds are issued on a Big R gift card after verification with Chapter/Club Leader had taken place. Limits do apply. Max of 1 large animal and 2 small animal sponsorships per person. Start date to enroll is from March 1st, 2024 to April 15th, 2024. Sign-up is limited to one Big R location. Signing at multiple Big R locations is prohibited. Program is limited to groups that are considered in our trade area for each store. This typically includes a radius of 15 miles from a Big R store with some exceptions. Program can be ended at anytime should limits be reached.




