## **2025 On-Demand Pesticide Applicator Training**

When: Applicators can receive CEU credits through this online workshop available from November 5th, 2025 - January 31st, 2026.

Fees: \$50 flat registration fee per person. This fee allows participants to earn all the CEU's they will need for the year. Website details: This fully online training has two separate sections, one for individuals needing pre-license training and the other for individuals needing CEU's to maintain their pesticide applicators license.



**PRE-LICENSE TRAINING:** These series of presentations are for those who are **not already** licensed and can learn all about New Mexico's pesticide rules and regulations and material which will help in preparation for the pesticide licensing exam. At the end of each module (pre-recorded presentation) will be a 5 question multiple choice quiz ,you must first watch the video before the quiz is accessible. You will need to pass this quiz with 100% accuracy. Direct link for Pre-license training registration (click here): Pre-License Pesticide Applicator

LICENSED (CEU) TRAINING: These series of presentations are for those that already have their license and need CEU's. This year for pesticide license renewals, our New Mexico State University Extension and Research Specialists will be recording a series of 1 hour presentations (modules) worth 1 CEU/mini-badge per presentation. Each pesticide applicator will be able to build their own program to fit their license requirements and topic interests.

Public applicators will need to listen to 4 presentations to fulfill their 4 CEU NMDA requirement. Private applicators will need to listen to 5 presentations to fulfill their 5 CEU NMDA requirement. At the end of each module (pre-recorded presentation) will be a 5 question multiple choice quiz. You must first watch the video before the quiz is accessible. You will need to pass this quiz with 100% accuracy to earn a CEU/mini-badge. Once your CEU requirement (based on your license type) is earned, you will automatically earn a badge of completion and NMDA will be sent the badge of completion and update your CEU's automatically.
