

(If picture is placed on Facebook, make sure to include the information below with the post). Photos submitted will then be placed on a link and voted on by the public. The information for the voting link will be made available on August 10th. The first, second and third place in each category will receive a rosette. The first place winner in each category will receive a camera case and his/her photo will automatically be entered in the contest for overall winner. The overall winner will be chosen by a set of judges and will be awarded an overall rosette and a cash prize of a \$100.

Categories -

- **4-H—Must have either correct logo or clover**
- **Animals - Any pictures that have animals**
- **People - Any pictures that have people**
- **Landscapes - Any pictures that have fields, any type of vegetation, flowers, mountains, sunsets, etc.**
- **Buildings - Any picture that have buildings Other -Anything that doesn't fit in a category**

Entry Rules -

- **Members May Submit *up to a total of THREE* entries. Each entry must have the following information with it — Name, Club, County, Name of Photo, Category, Location of the photo and Contact number/email**
- **Entries can be either color or black and white. Please no edited or photo-shopped pictures.**
- **Photos WILL NOT be returned!! If you want to keep you photo, please retain a copy**
- **Photographs must be the work of the 4-H member taken during the current 4-H program year**
- **Entries must be in the State Office OR uploaded to Facebook by August 2, 2021 — Send to State 4-H Office, MSC 3AE, New Mexico State University, Box 30003, Las Cruces NM, 88003**
